 - o Grading, administering or developing written or practical tests for the student.
 - o Providing reagents or anything else that might incur costs to themselves or their facility.
 - o Preparing lectures or providing books or other materials.
- Qualifications for a mentor:
 - SBB(ASCP) or a Pathologist that is board certified in Transfusion Medicine. Other qualifications may be submitted for consideration and approved by the LBC Education Coordinator.
 - Employed in some capacity at a blood center or transfusion service.
